I. A Greater & More Perfect Tabernacle (Hebrews 9:11-28)

- A. A new order of the priesthood after the order of Melchizedek
- B. A new covenant through the blood of Christ Himself
- C. The blood which cleanses the conscience & makes righteous
- D. Christ entered the heavenly Holy of Holies and sprinkled the eternal sacrifice of His blood which removes the transgressions once and for all

II. The Inadequacy of the Law, both Priestly and Moral (Hebrews 10:1-18)

- A. The Law is only a shadow of good things to come
- B. The Law cannot make perfect those who draw near through it & its sacrifices
- C. God takes away the first, Moses' and Levitical Law, in order to establish the second
 - D. By this we have been sanctified by the body of Jesus once and for all
 - E. Under the Old Covenant sacrifices were offered daily for sin, though they could not cleanse
 - F. Jesus has perfected for all time those who are sanctified
 - 1. God's moral law is written upon our hearts
 - 2. Our sins and lawless deeds He will remember no more
 - 3. Where there is forgiveness there is no longer any offering for sin

III. Let Us Enter the Holy Place by a New and Living Way (Hebrews 10:19-25)

- A. We have a great High Priest over the household of God
- B. Our hearts have been sprinkled clean and our bodies washed with pure water
- C. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering
- D. And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds
- 1. not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together
- 2. But encouraging one another as we see the day approaching
