Psalm 139

INTRO: Psalm 139 reviews some of the marvelous non-moral attributes of God and how they particularly apply to each individual.

- I. God's Omniscience (vv.1-6)
God knows everything about us, each one of us individually, all at the same time.

- II. God's Omnipresence (vv.7-12)
God is always with us no matter where we go.

- III. God's Creation of us Individually (vv.13-16)
God designed each one of us with our own unique blend of aptitudes, talents, & gifts.
If anyone ever doubted these verses make clear that God has a plan for each of our lives.

- IV. As David Contemplates these Truths, He is Overwhelmed (vv.17-18)
He imagines a nearly infinite number of God's thoughts toward him, and he is only one
Of billions of people!!
