\* Blameless describes a person of authenticity and transparency, not perfection by a moral checklist." David Thompson, p. 109

II. (v.3) Those who refuse to gossip  
or harm their neighbor  
or speak evil of their friends

III. (v.4a-b) Those who despise flagrant sinners,  
and honor the faithful followers of the Lord.

IV. (v.4c-5) Those who keep their promises even when it hurts  
- who lend money without charging interest  
- who cannot be bribed to lie about the innocent.

V. (5c) Such people will stand firm  
[in God's Presence] forever
